SEWP VI Ordering Process

The NASA SEWP Quote Request Tool (QRT) is the preferred method for obtaining compliant SEWP quotations that satisfy FAR requirements. Orders are submitted through the NASA SEWP Program Management Office (PMO).

The NASA SEWP VI Contract is available to all Federal Agencies and authorized contractors. Through SEWP, agencies can efficiently procure information technology products and services while leveraging pre-negotiated contract terms and competitive pricing.

Step 1

End User / Contracting Officer

1. Identify the required products and/or services.
2. Obtain a SEWP quote through the SEWP QRT.
3. Create a delivery order using the applicable NASA SEWP contract vehicle.
4. Submit the order to the NASA SEWP PMO.

Step 2

NASA SEWP PMO

1. Reviews the order for completeness and compliance.
2. Routes the order to the appropriate contract holder.

Step 3

IT Trends, LLC

1. Processes the order.
2. Coordinates procurement and fulfillment.
3. Delivers products and/or services.
4. Provides invoicing and post-delivery support.
